Unpaid Meal Debt: Lessons from Nebraska and the Nation

Unpaid meal debt is one of the most challenging issues facing school nutrition programs around the country - especially after the end of COVID waivers last year and ongoing increases in food costs. The USDA has left it up to districts to navigate the issue but we do have models to learn from!
